<p>5. Management Plan updates</p>	<p>pilot project on retrofit at Manningham. It is often hard to find consistent solutions. AndrewG has an aim to work with supply chain and wants feedback to go to suppliers. Grants being sought.</p> <p>General discussion on sources of heating – gas, ground/air source heat pumps, (may be too noisy in close proximity to other houses), District Heat systems, hydrogen (too expensive). Mechanical heat exchange ventilators – may have some potential. Setting Survey has been updated and found that – 8 Views have improved, none deteriorated, and others remained the same.</p> <p>Cllr AW – raised the issue of shop front signage in the Buffer Zone at Saltaire Mini Market (Bargain Booze) on Saltaire Road. Enforcement have this on their long list of cases to consider.</p> <p>UK asked about BT Openreach Boxes. SC met Openreach in 2023 and the following was agreed.</p> <p>Fibre Broadband Boxes</p> <p>Where these are proposed on the front elevation, they will need Listed Building Consent and is not recommended. Following recent liaison with Openreach (June 2023), they confirm that Internal CSP Customer Service Points (boxes) will be installed inside houses for any future requests in Saltaire World Heritage Site. We encourage the provider to try to minimise the amount of wiring on the front of properties by putting wires internally within the property at the earliest opportunity, and to drill holes within mortar, rather than stone where possible.</p> <p>Since then, SC has found the following information on websites.... If you require high-speed, reliable, and low-latency connections for activities like gaming or streaming, a wired connection is your best bet. If flexibility, convenience, and mobility are important to you, a wireless connection provides the freedom to connect multiple devices seamlessly.</p> <p>A viable alternative choice is to install a mesh based wireless solution where each access point communicates to the next hop over wireless and only the root node is connected to ethernet cabling. https://networkingplus.co.uk/feature-details?itemid=3612&post=connectivity-in-old-buildings-175719</p> <p>Summary – over 500 responses received.
