### Transcript of Denholme Walking Schedule

**Number of Path as shown on the Map** - "~~53~~ 40"

**Type of Path** - "*Cart Road used as a public path*"

**Starting Point of Path** - "*Whalley Lane 100 yards east of Meal Bridge*"

**Ultimate destination** - "*Denholme District Council Boundary at Gleid Hill*"

**Information etc.** - *Leaves Whalley Lane in a northerly direction along a cart road, passing the approach to Wood Nook Cottages and then beneath a railway arch (14 yards in length) Approx. 100 Yards north of this railway arch the path passes through an iron wicket gate on the east side of a field gate and continues to a second wicket gate (...missing word) the north side of a field gate on the Denholme Urban District Boundary.*

*Within the precinct of the two gates are notice boards indicating that the land west of the path is private.....Uninterrupted user by public for over 40 years"*

**Width and general condition...** - "*Average width 3 yards. Rough metalled with local stone . in poor condition*"

**Name of the person who carried out the survey** - "*Mr. Plummer, Surveyor, Council Offices, Denholme. 19<sup>th</sup> October 1950*".
