ADOPTION STATEMENT

(a) Regulations and Adoption:

This Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 and gives notice that the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council has resolved to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) at Executive on **02 December 2025**. This revised SCI replaces all previous versions of the SCI.

(b) Subject Matter of, and the area covered by, the SCI:

The Statement of Community Involvement primarily sets out the council's policy in relation to public engagement in the preparation and review of planning documents and consideration of planning applications.

(c) Legal Challenge

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SCI. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event within 3 months after the day on which the SCI was adopted.
