



2021 Census deprivation at household level

Introduction

The Census took place on 21 March 2021. The first set of results from the 2021 Census show that the total population for Bradford District is 546,400 and the total number of households is 209,900.

Households by deprivation dimensions

The 2021 Census data has been used to produce estimates that classify households in England and Wales by four dimensions of deprivation: employment, education, health and disability and household overcrowding.

This information is available at District level.

The results for Bradford District show that – 43% of households are not deprived, 34.4% of households are deprived in 1 dimension, 16.8% are deprived in 2 dimensions, 5.4% are deprived in 3 dimensions and 0.4% are deprived in 4 dimensions.

The dimensions of deprivation used to classify households are based on four selected household characteristics:

Education: a household is classified as deprived in the education sector if no one has at least level 2 education and no one aged 16 to 18 years as a full-time student

Employment: a household is classified as deprived in the employment dimension if any member, not a full-time student is either unemployed or disabled

Health: a household is classified as deprived in the health dimension if any member is disabled

Housing: a household is classified in the housing dimension if the household's accommodation is either overcrowded, in a shared dwelling, or has no central heating

ONS will be publishing other main data from the Census within two years of the Census data. This will also become available at Ward, LSOA and MSOA level. On-the-day alerts and briefing notes will be produced as soon as the information at these levels becomes available
