##### *Survey of Rights of Way*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section 3 of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statements prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the areas of the Boroughs of Keighley (except for the Central Area) and Pudsey, the Urban Districts of Aireborough, Barnoldswick, Bingley, Earby, Horsforth, Ilkley, Otley, Shipley, Silsden and Skipton, and the Parishes set out below in the Rural Districts of Bowland, Settle, Skipton and Wharfedale by the deletion and or addition of the paths indicated in the Schedule hereto and shown on a map which has been deposited at the Office of the County Engineer and Surveyor at 93 Northgate, Wakefield, and which may be seen there until the 1st day of November 1965, free of charge, between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 5.20 p.m. on each weekday (other than Saturday).

During the same period copies of the map so far as the same relate to each of the County Districts affected will be on deposit and may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at the respective Council Offices.
